You might wonder who is Mission Moldova What do they do? How can I help?

Moldova is a landlocked country of the former Soviet Union between Romania and Ukraine with a population of over 4.3 million people.

Our work here in Cornwall commenced in 2001, since then we have sent Humanitarian Aid covering large areas of Moldova, helping many people who still live in poverty, and are in great need of your help.

In the past we sent needed items which included 8Ambulances,a Mobile Dental unit, and Dental equipment to furnish 4 Dental Surgeries

All funds to send our Articulated lorry are raised in Supermarkets, by your donations, and help from proceeds of our shop in Liskeard.

We are most grateful for all the help we receive.

Following the collapse of Communism in 1991 and the country becoming independent, farms were rapidly becoming dismantled leaving people without resources to develop their communities. Even today many villages are without basic utilities such as gas, running water. or sewerage and are linked by dirt tracks that are often impassable during winter. Most people live below the subsistence level of approximately £60 per month, these conditions conspire to lock people into poverty. Many children are without parental care, and many remain in orphanages.

Many of the elderly have no chance of work, see no future, and in rural areas unemployment can be as high as 90%

From the medical aspect at least 30% suffer chronic disease with inadequate local medical facilities, if any exist at all. People have to stay at home because they have no permanent local doctor and medicine is too expensive. In emergency there are often no ambulances to take the sick to hospital which may be as much as 40 kilometres away, often help comes too late.

We now run a family support scheme by sending funds to the local Pastor Slavic Duman to purchase food in bulk, Slavic and his team make up parcels of food, then in turn seek out many individuals living in squaller with many families in the country who are really staving as they are not given enough money to survive, there are no religious barriers who receive the food, no monies are handed over by Slavic as there is a great temptation by the men folk for alcoholic abuse.

We can guarantee to you after all these years your giving has made such a big difference to many people in Moldova bringing back a new life what we take every day for granted, we are not giving up on this country or its people ,but we do need your support

Our group is not affiliated to any other organisation working in Moldova or Romania, and persons who help our Mission receive no remuneration. Members of our Committee endeavour to make annual visits on behalf of our Charity.

These visits are entirely self funded

Before you decide to throw away items you no longer require, or family members have to downsize, please consider our Charity. Your giving will bring much warmth and comfort to those less fortunate than ourselves. Items that we are unable to send to Moldova are sent to Romania or where needed
